

Save the Dates for the 123rd Annual Convention, May 13, 14 and 15, 2022 at Kalahari Resort & Convention Center, Sandusky, OH. Details are on at KofCOhio.org. Your council should avail itself of the full representation at this convention by having two (2) accredited delegates attending. The success of the work of our Order in Ohio and your council depends on your council's full participation at the annual convention.

The rules of the Order provide:

- 1. The Grand Knight, by virtue of his office, will be a delegate.
- 2. The other delegate must be selected from among the Past Grand Knights of your council if they can attend. If there are NO Past Grand Knights available, any third-degree member in good standing may be elected.
- 3. That alternates for the two (2) delegates are also elected. They need not be Past Grand Knights but must be third-degree members in good standing.

Finally, just a remind the **First Phase of the Charities Campaign will end Thursday, April 1, 2022.** A council must sell and submit to the State Treasurer a minimum of one -and one-half (1 ½) tickets per member by April 1, 2022 to qualify for a rebate. The rebate will be 60 cents per ticket on all tickets sold and remitted in the First Phase. I look forward to seeing you all very soon.
